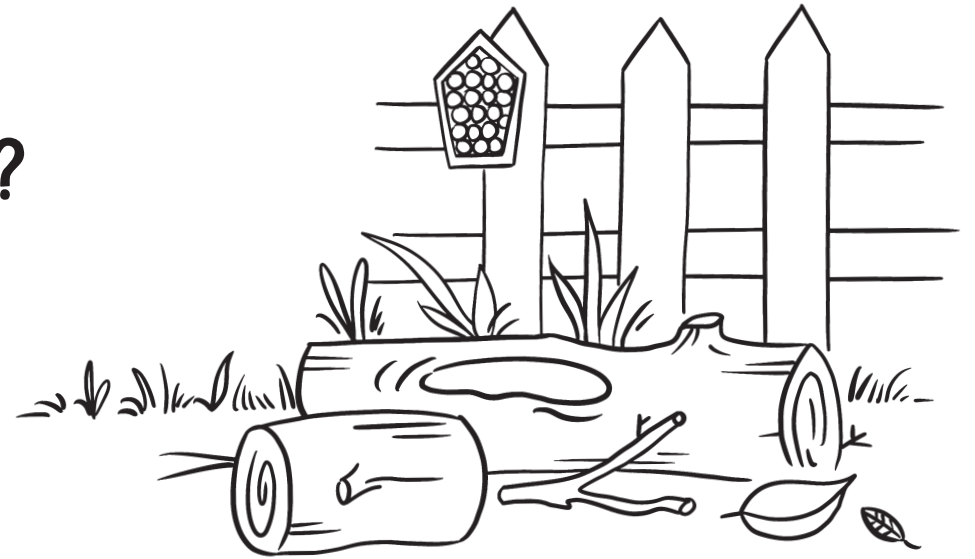


WHICH PLANTS AND ANIMALS ENJOY LIVING IN YOUR GARDEN?
