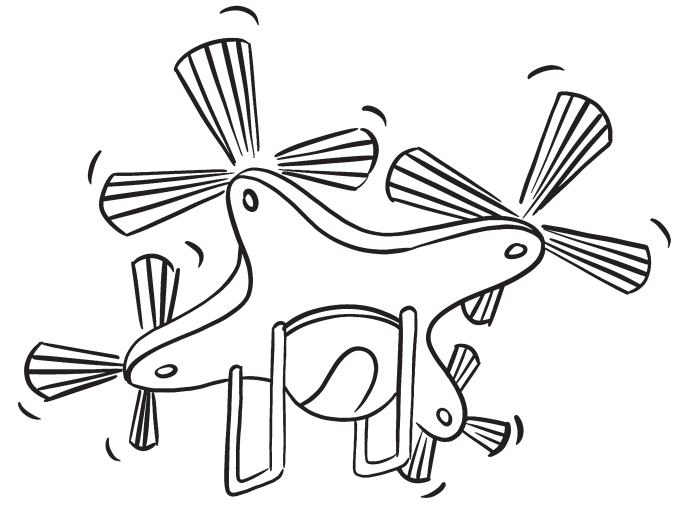


WHAT DOES YOUR DRONE SEE IN THE MEADOW?

Orchards are home to many different types of fruit trees: apples, pears, cherries and plums. The wide variety of trees helps insects and animals feel right at home. These orchards protect many species of animals — along with rare varieties of fruit trees that might no longer be planted because they need to be harvested by hand. To learn how to care for these meadows more easily, researchers monitor them with drones. The drones fly over and gather information about the trees and their health. And they even count the number of blossoms and fruits growing on the tree. But you still have to pick them yourself.
